ABOUT CLOUD CITY

The beautiful Cloud City, known for its aesthetics and luxury, was founded as a Tibanna gas mining colony. It has a population of several million tourists, workers and support staff all hovering over the gas giant, Bespin. The station floats 36,660 miles above Bespin's core, while its disk is approximately 10 miles in diameter. 3,600 repulsorlift engines and tractor beam generators keep the giant city floating above the planet. The city possesses 392 levels, which include platforms and rooms for residents and visitors. The top 50 levels of the city are used as a luxury resort, with famous casinos such as Yarith, Bespin and Pair O'Dice. Meanwhile, the lower levels are used as worker housing for those handling the mining and processing of Tibanna gas.

The Tibanna gas mining process is performed thanks to tractor beams emitted from the underside of the city, converging below the gas mine's reactor bulb to

create a funnel of energy that mines Tibanna gas from Bespin's lower atmosphere, at depths of more than 14,291 miles. The gas is forced up into an opening at the bottom of the bulb, where it travels up the reactor stalk and finally into one of several smaller reactor shafts, where it is filtered through a processing vane. Each vane maintains a carbon-freeze chamber, where Tibanna gas is mixed with carbonite for flash-freeze preservation. One of the chambers was famously used to freeze the smuggler Han Solo™ in carbonite after Imperial forces captured him.

A stay at Cloud City is a memorable but often expensive experience, with luxury resorts often charging as much as 5,000 Imperial credits per night. Popular tourist activities include gambling, cloud car sightseeing tours of the city and occasional tours of the local mining operations.

MEET THE MODEL DESIGNER

Hans Burkhard Schlömer

What was the first step in recreating Cloud City as a LEGO® set?

One could say I started early! Years before it was even decided to develop a new Cloud City, I built a small-scale *Slave I*, Boba Fett's ship, with a later Bespin set in mind. As a LEGO *Star Wars* fan and collector myself, Cloud City was always at the top of my personal wish list, so I began thinking about different concepts early on. To me, *Slave I* belongs to Cloud City. Any play set just wouldn't feel complete without it.

Later in the design process I realized that I had to make room inside to store the block of carbonite with frozen Han Solo™—how could Boba Fett™ transport his bounty otherwise? This was quite a challenge with such a small model!

What reference materials did you use?

The main source of reference and inspiration were screenshots from Episode V, *THE EMPIRE STRIKES BACK*. It is interesting to see how light conditions change on the movie set, which affects the colors of some areas. I believe it is early morning when our heroes arrive. Then the day goes by, and when they make their escape the sun is just setting. This was important to keep in mind when choosing colors for the landing platform, for example—I know it really is plain gray, but we never see it like this in the movie. This is why I went with warmer tan and dark tan colors for this area.

What is uniquely inspirational about the Cloud City setting?

To me as a designer, the movie's set design is simply amazing. It is a very subtle art deco style. There are so many little details to discover once one starts paying attention. I wanted to have those details in my set. All of them!

The mood and colors also change when moving from one area to the next. It is like a color code! While rooms and corridors initially are mostly white, open and airy, this quickly gives way to an oppressive dark red when entering the prison area. My favorite detail is the "menacing eyes" in the outer walls of the prison cells - light fixtures glowering at people walking by.

What was the most challenging part of the design process?

Cloud City was not a totally straight design process. Most of the interior has been there from the beginning in one form or another, but the overall concept has changed several times. One big challenge was how to tie all the rooms together in order to give the model shape. The four beams on top outlining the roof/outer shell of Cloud City do this job efficiently without blocking any of the play areas. The goal was to achieve a design language similar to our Death Star play set, just less brick-heavy and with all rooms arranged on one level.

What is your favorite feature of the set?

I actually have two favorite features! One is that the rooms are arranged in a logical way, allowing the whole storyline to be played out just like in the movie. The other is that there are two smaller vehicles with the set, one of them a twin-pod cloud car – a vehicle we haven't seen in LEGO® form for a very long time!

How is this set different from others you have done in the past?

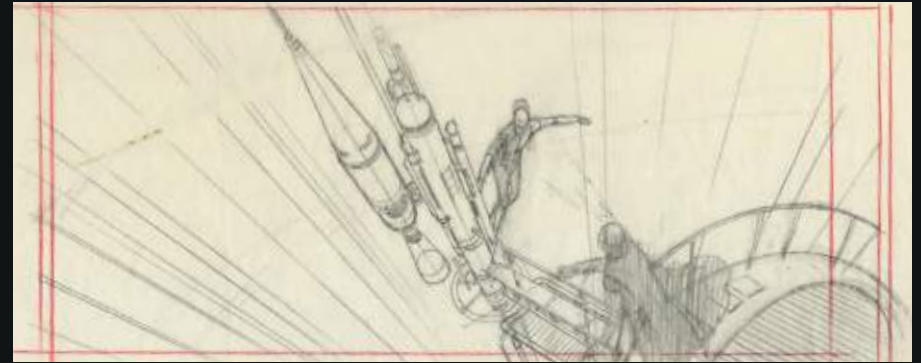
Cloud City is certainly the biggest play set I have done so far. Designing it took me even longer than the UCS *Millennium Falcon*™!

Was there anything in the original design that didn't make it to the final design?

From the outside, Cloud City appears like a hovering mushroom. However, my design brief specifically requested a play set, and play sets need to have solid supports and be accessible. This means lifting the whole set far up on a stand and closing it off with covers was not an option. To achieve the quality we want to deliver, a solution with a platform closer to the ground was required. Aside from that, pretty much everything else I wanted to have in the set made it into the box!

What about the set might surprise builders?

The variety of different builds in this set may come as a surprise, albeit a pleasant one! For example, bag two gives you a wide variety of elements to build a detailed spacecraft. And with the following bag you get—bricks only! Big bricks, at that, to create the cross-shaped base of Cloud City. Overall, the building sequence is supposed to make sense, be interesting, and deliver a great building experience until the last bag. Enjoy your stay in the clouds!

MEET THE GRAPHIC DESIGNER

Madison O'Neil

What is the first step in designing the minifigures?

The very first steps would be establishing which characters to include in the set and determining the design needs of those characters. Are any new elements needed, or are existing elements needed in new colors? How many printed elements are necessary? Do the characters require textiles? What are the best ways to create novelty and excitement in these classic characters? Once these questions are answered we can begin the more specific design tasks.

What kind of reference material did you use?

Cloud City is an iconic classic location, so reference material was easy to assemble. My favorite way to gather reference is to search through the film and take screenshots of the specific scenes or characters I need. I find that even after seeing the film countless times I still discover new details. My biggest surprise in this set was when I realized the inside of Lando's cape is stitched with an intricate pattern, a detail we were able to incorporate into his minifigure.

How did you approach conveying a character's personality in their design?

For minifigures, I find that the vast majority of the personality must come from the facial expressions. On the front side of a minifigure's head we will generally design a character with a slightly neutral expression, a gentle smile or light frown depending on who it is. It's on the back of the head where we push the expression further to capture another aspect of the character's personality or story. For example, Lando's big charming smile, or Luke's shock when he realizes (spoiler alert) that Darth Vader™ is his father.

Even though minifigures are small, often they require a lot of detail. How did you approach incorporating detailed “costumes” and faces on such small figures?

There is a certain level of detail that is considered “LEGO® Star Wars DNA” and anything beyond that starts to fall away from our established design aesthetic. Design for minifigures becomes about prioritizing the most important and iconic aspects of the characters, while perhaps eliminating those details that might not translate well to the minifigure scale.

What was your favorite minifigure to design? What was the most difficult minifigure to design?

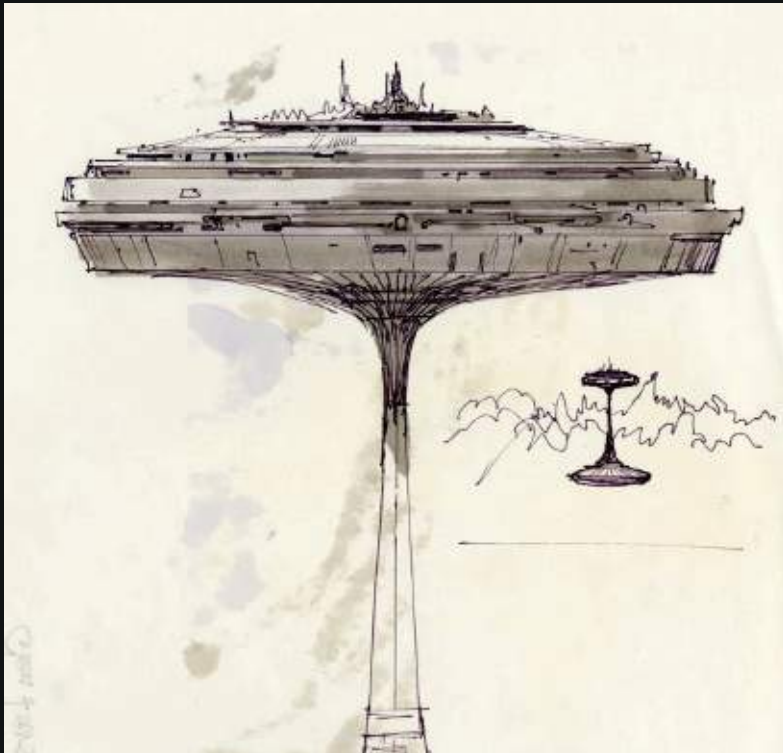
My favorite decorations in this set happen to also be the ones that were the most challenging to create. It was a tricky task to translate the pattern on Princess Leia's Cloud City dress down to minifigure scale, and the same goes for the repeating pattern inside Lando's cape. But, I feel that these details and new costumes are exciting additions to the LEGO Star Wars assortment and will get fans excited.



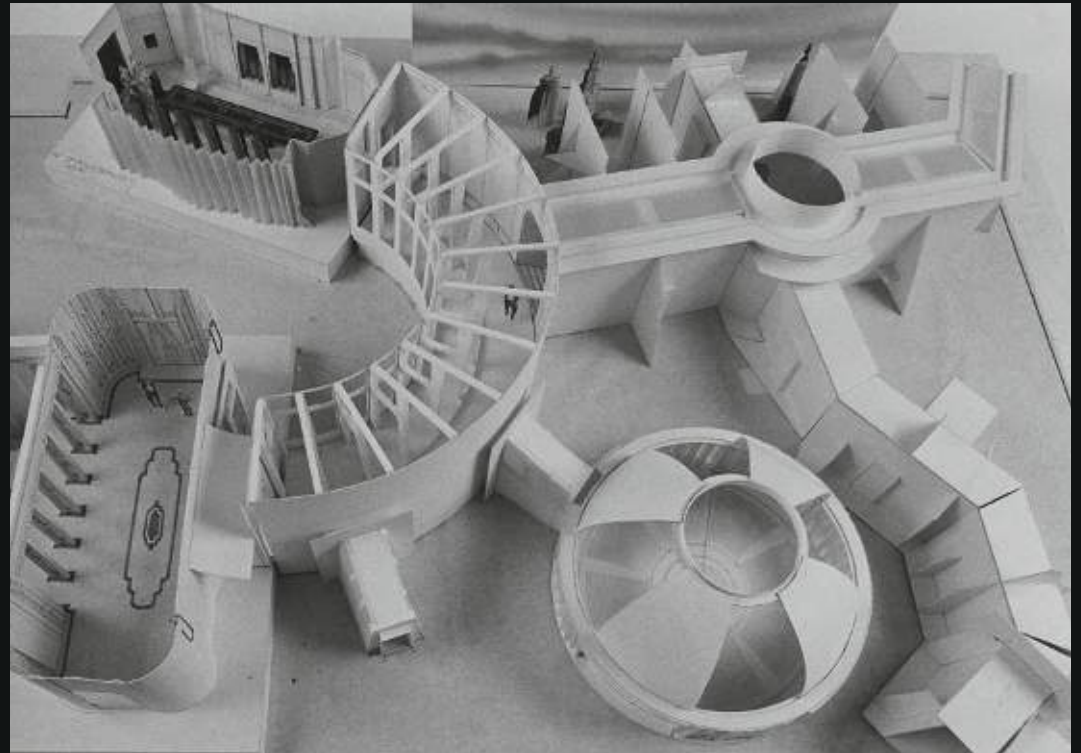

À PROPOS DE LA CITÉ DES NUAGES

La belle Cité des Nuages, réputée pour son esthétique et son luxe, a été fondée en tant que colonie minière produisant du gaz Tibanna. Elle a une population de plusieurs millions de touristes, de travailleurs et de personnel de soutien, planant tous sur Bespin, la planète gazeuse géante. La station flotte à 59 000 kilomètres au-dessus du centre de Bespin, tandis que son disque est d'environ 16,2 kilomètres de diamètre. 3 600 répulseurs et générateurs de rayons tracteurs permettent à la ville géante de flotter au-dessus de la planète. La ville possède 392 niveaux, qui comprennent des plates-formes et des pièces pour les résidents et les visiteurs. Les 50 premiers niveaux de la ville sont utilisés comme complexe touristique de luxe, avec des casinos célèbres tels que Yarith, Bespin et Pair O'Dice. Les niveaux inférieurs sont eux utilisés comme logements pour les travailleurs effectuant l'extraction et le traitement du gaz Tibanna.

Le processus d'extraction du gaz Tibanna est réalisé grâce à des rayons tracteurs émis depuis le dessous de la ville, convergeant sous le bulbe du réacteur de la mine de gaz pour

créer une cheminée d'énergie qui extrait le gaz Tibanna depuis l'atmosphère inférieure de Bespin, à des profondeurs de plus de 23 000 kilomètres. Le gaz est poussé vers le haut dans une ouverture au fond du bulbe, où il se déplace vers le haut de la tige de réacteur et finalement dans l'un des arbres de réacteur plus petits, où il est filtré par une aube de traitement. Chaque aube maintient une chambre de congélation carbonique, où le gaz Tibanna est mélangé avec de la carbonite pour une préservation en congélation instantanée. Une des chambres est célèbre pour avoir été utilisée pour congeler le contrebandier Han Solo™ dans la carbonite après que les forces impériales l'aient capturé.

Un séjour dans la Cité des Nuages est une expérience inoubliable mais souvent coûteuse, avec des complexes touristiques de luxe coûtant souvent plus de 5 000 crédits impériaux par nuit. Les activités touristiques populaires incluent le jeu, les visites guidées de la ville et les visites occasionnelles des opérations minières locales.

RENCONTRE AVEC LE DESIGNER DU MODÈLE

Hans Burkhard Schlömer

Quelle a été la première étape de la recréation de la Cité des Nuages en tant qu'ensemble LEGO® ?

On pourrait dire que j'ai commencé tôt ! Des années avant même de décider de concevoir une nouvelle Cité des Nuages, j'ai construit une version à petite échelle du *Slave I*, le vaisseau de Boba Fett™, avec l'idée d'un ensemble Bospin ultérieur. En tant que fan et collectionneur de LEGO *Star Wars*, la Cité des Nuages a toujours été au sommet de ma liste de souhaits personnels, alors j'ai commencé à penser à différents concepts dès le début. Pour moi, le *Slave I* appartient à la Cité des Nuages. Tout ensemble ne semblerait pas complet sans cela.

Plus tard dans le processus de conception, j'ai réalisé que je devais faire de la place à l'intérieur pour le bloc de carbonite dans lequel Han Solo™ est congelé : comment Boba Fett pourrait-il transporter sa prime autrement ? C'était un vrai défi avec un si petit modèle !

Quels documents de référence avez-vous utilisés ?

La principale source de référence et d'inspiration a été des captures d'écran de l'Épisode V, *L'EMPIRE CONTRE-ATTAQUE*. Il est intéressant de voir comment les conditions de lumière changent sur le plateau du film, ce qui affecte les couleurs de certaines zones. Je crois qu'il est tôt le matin quand nos héros arrivent. Puis le jour passe, et quand ils s'évadent, le soleil se couche. Il était important d'y penser lors du choix des couleurs pour la plate-forme d'atterrissage, par exemple. Je sais qu'en réalité elle est grise, mais nous ne la voyons jamais comme ça dans le film. C'est pourquoi j'ai choisi des couleurs plus chaudes, beige et beige foncé, pour cette zone.

Qu'est-ce qui est particulièrement inspirant sur le décor de la Cité des Nuages ?

Pour moi, en tant que designer, la conception du décor du film est tout simplement incroyable. C'est un style Art déco très subtil. Il y a tellement de petits détails à découvrir une fois que l'on commence à y faire attention. Je voulais avoir ces détails dans mon ensemble. Tous !

L'ambiance et les couleurs changent également en passant d'une zone à l'autre. C'est comme un code de couleurs ! Alors que les pièces et les couloirs sont d'abord principalement blancs, ouverts et aérés, cela cède rapidement la place à un oppressant rouge foncé en entrant dans la zone carcérale. Mes détails préférés sont les « yeux menaçants » dans les murs extérieurs des cellules de la prison - des lumières terribles regardant d'un air méchant les gens qui marchent.

Quelle a été la partie la plus complexe dans la création de cet ensemble ?

Le processus de conception de la Cité des Nuages n'était pas aisé. La plus grande partie de l'intérieur était là dès le début sous une forme ou une autre, mais le concept global a changé à plusieurs reprises. Un grand défi était de savoir comment attacher toutes les pièces ensemble afin de donner sa forme au modèle. Les quatre poutres sur le dessus décrivant le toit/la coquille extérieure de la Cité des Nuages font ce travail efficacement sans bloquer aucune zone de jeu. L'objectif était de parvenir à un langage de conception similaire à notre ensemble de l'Étoile de la Mort, avec moins de briques et avec toutes les pièces disposées sur un niveau.

Quelle est votre caractéristique préférée de l'ensemble ?

En fait, j'ai deux caractéristiques préférées ! L'une est que les pièces sont arrangées d'une manière logique, permettant à l'histoire entière d'être jouée comme dans le film. L'autre est qu'il y a deux véhicules plus petits avec l'ensemble, l'un d'eux une voiture des nuages à doubles capsules, un véhicule que nous n'avons pas vu sous forme LEGO® depuis très longtemps !

En quoi cet ensemble est-il différent des autres que vous avez faits dans le passé ?

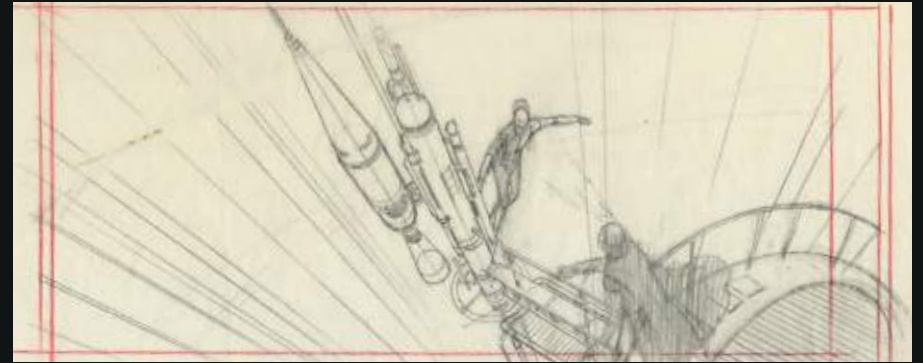
La Cité des Nuages est certainement le plus grand ensemble que j'ai fait jusqu'à présent. Concevoir cet ensemble m'a pris encore plus de temps que le *Millennium Falcon*™ de la série de collection suprême !

Y a-t-il quelque chose dans la conception originale qui a été éliminé de la conception finale ?

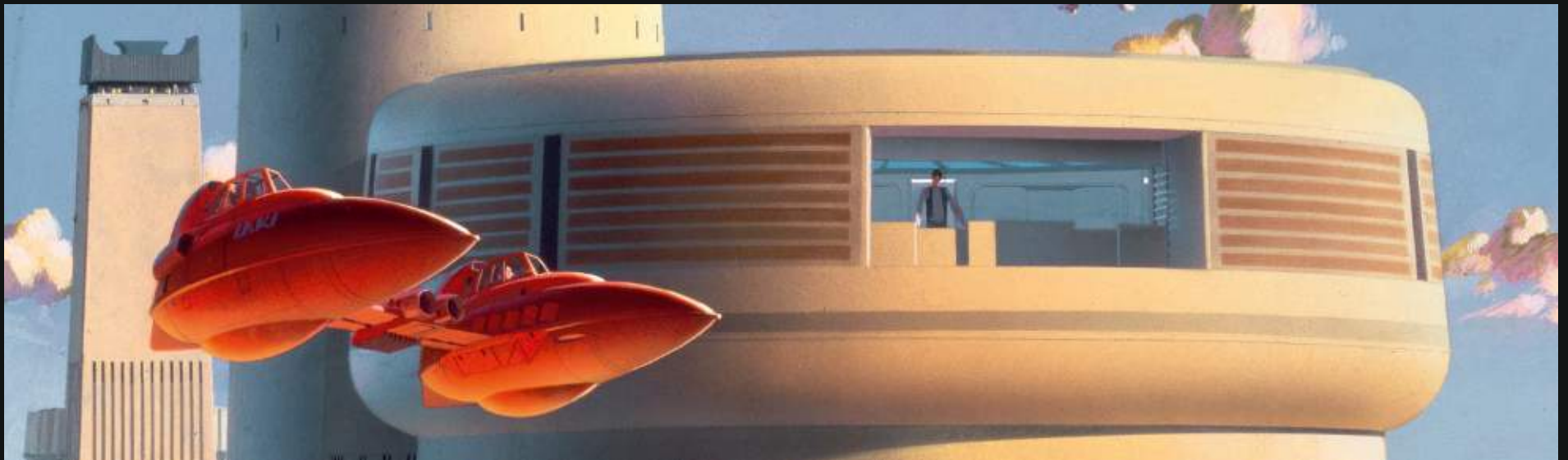
De l'extérieur, la Cité des Nuages ressemble à un champignon en vol stationnaire. Cependant, mon énoncé de conception demandait spécifiquement un ensemble de jeu, et les ensembles de jeu doivent avoir des supports solides et être accessibles. Cela signifie qu'élever l'ensemble sur un support et le fermer avec des couvercles n'était pas une option. Pour atteindre la qualité que nous voulons offrir, une solution avec une plate-forme plus proche du sol était requise. Mis à part cela, à peu près tout ce que je voulais avoir dans l'ensemble se trouve dans la boîte !

Qu'est-ce qui pourrait étonner les constructeurs dans cet ensemble ?

La variété des différentes constructions dans cet ensemble peut être une surprise, mais agréable ! Par exemple, le sac deux vous donne une grande variété d'éléments pour construire un vaisseau spatial détaillé. Et avec le sac suivant, vous obtenez... seulement des briques ! De grandes briques, pour créer la base en forme de croix de la Cité des Nuages. Dans l'ensemble, la séquence de construction est censée avoir du sens, être intéressante, et livrer une grande expérience de construction jusqu'au dernier sac. Profitez de votre séjour dans les nuages !

RENCONTRE AVEC LE GRAPHISTE

Quelle est la première étape dans la conception des figurines ?

Les tout premiers pas seraient de décider quels personnages inclure dans l'ensemble et de déterminer les besoins de conception de ces personnages. Des éléments nouveaux ou existants sont-ils nécessaires dans de nouvelles couleurs ? Combien d'éléments imprimés sont nécessaires ? Les personnages nécessitent-ils des textiles ? Quelles sont les meilleures façons de créer de la nouveauté et de l'enthousiasme dans ces personnages classiques ? Une fois que ces questions sont résolues, nous pouvons commencer les tâches de conception plus spécifiques.

Quel type de documents de référence avez-vous utilisé ?

La Cité des Nuages est un lieu classique emblématique, le matériel de référence était donc facile à réunir. Ma manière préférée de rassembler des références est de chercher dans le film et de prendre des captures d'écran des scènes ou des personnages spécifiques dont j'ai besoin. Je trouve que même après avoir vu le film d'innombrables fois, je continue à découvrir de nouveaux détails. Ma plus grande surprise dans cet ensemble a été quand j'ai réalisé que l'intérieur de la cape de Lando est cousu avec un motif complexe, un détail que nous avons pu intégrer dans sa figurine.

Comment avez-vous abordé le fait de transmettre la personnalité d'un personnage dans sa conception ?

Pour les figurines, je trouve que la majorité de leur personnalité doit venir des expressions faciales. Sur l'avant de la tête d'une figurine, nous concevons généralement un personnage avec une expression légèrement neutre, un sourire doux ou un froncement de sourcils léger, selon de qui il s'agit. C'est sur l'arrière de la tête que nous poussons l'expression plus loin pour capturer un autre aspect de la personnalité ou de l'histoire du personnage. Par exemple, le grand sourire charmant de Lando, ou le choc de Luke quand il se rend compte (attention divulgâcheur) que Dark Vador™ est son père.

Même si les figurines sont petites, elles exigent souvent beaucoup de détails.

Comment avez-vous abordé l'incorporation de « costumes » et de visages détaillés sur de si petites figures ?

Il y a un certain niveau de détail qui est considéré comme « l'ADN LEGO® Star Wars » et tout ce qui va au-delà s'éloigne de notre esthétique de conception établie. Concevoir des figurines implique de hiérarchiser les aspects les plus importants et les plus emblématiques des personnages, tout en éliminant peut-être les détails qui pourraient ne pas bien se traduire à l'échelle d'une figurine.

Quelle a été la figurine que vous avez préféré concevoir ? Quelle a été la figurine la plus difficile à concevoir ?

Mes décorations préférées dans cet ensemble se trouvent être celles qui ont aussi été les plus difficiles à créer. C'était une tâche délicate de reproduire le modèle de la robe de la Cité des Nuages de la Princesse Leia à l'échelle d'une figurine, et il en va de même pour le motif répétitif à l'intérieur de la cape de Lando. Mais je pense que ces détails et de nouveaux costumes sont des ajouts passionnants à l'assortiment LEGO Star Wars et raviront les fans.



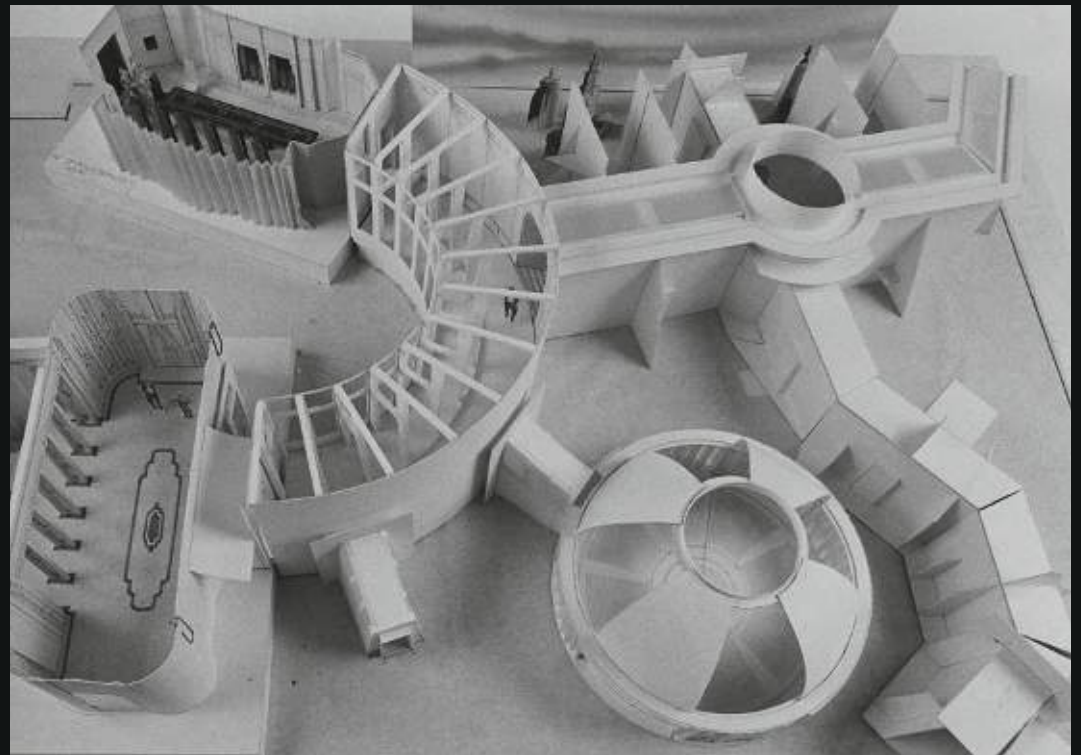

ACERCA DE LA CIUDAD DE LAS NUBES

La hermosa Ciudad de las Nubes, conocida por su belleza y sus lujos, fue en sus orígenes una colonia dedicada a la extracción de gas Tibanna. Posee una población de varios millones de turistas, trabajadores y profesionales de apoyo, todos ellos suspendidos sobre el gigante gaseoso llamado Bespín. La estación flota a 59.000 kilómetros por encima del núcleo de Bespín, mientras que su disco mide unos 16,2 kilómetros de diámetro. 3.600 repulsores y generadores de rayos de tracción mantienen a la gigantesca ciudad flotando sobre el planeta. La ciudad en sí cuenta con 392 niveles e incluye plataformas y habitaciones para residentes y visitantes. Los 50 niveles más altos de la ciudad integran un centro turístico de lujo del que forman parte casinos tan famosos como el Yarith, el Bespín o el Pair O'Dice. Los niveles inferiores, por su parte, se usan para albergar a los trabajadores que se dedican a extraer y procesar el gas Tibanna.

El proceso de extracción del gas Tibanna se lleva a cabo mediante una serie de rayos de tracción emitidos por la parte inferior de la ciudad que convergen debajo del bulbo reactor de la mina, creando un canal de energía que extrae el gas de la atmósfera inferior

de Bespín a profundidades de más de 23.000 kilómetros. El gas asciende, atravesando una abertura ubicada en el extremo inferior del bulbo desde la que sube por el tallo del reactor y, finalmente, se deriva hacia uno de sus ejes menores, donde se filtra mediante una aleta de procesamiento.

Cada aleta contiene una cámara de congelación en carbonita donde el gas Tibanna se mezcla con dicho material para congelarlo rápidamente y, de este modo, conservarlo. Fue una de estas cámaras la que se usó para congelar en carbonita al contrabandista Han Solo™ luego de su captura por las fuerzas imperiales.

Descansar en la Ciudad de las Nubes es una experiencia memorable, aunque, con frecuencia, muy cara: los centros turísticos de lujo suelen cobrar hasta 5.000 créditos imperiales por noche. Algunas de las actividades más populares entre los turistas son las apuestas, los paseos por la ciudad en auto-nube y las ocasionales visitas a las operaciones mineras locales.

CONOCE AL DISEÑADOR DEL MODELO

Hans Burkhard Schlömer

Llegado el momento de convertir a la Ciudad de las Nubes en un set LEGO®, ¿cuál fue el primer paso?

¡Se podría decir que empecé temprano! Años antes de que se decidiera siquiera desarrollar una nueva Ciudad de las Nubes, construí una pequeña *Esclavo I*, la nave de Boba Fett™, pensando en un futuro set basado en Bespin. Como fan de LEGO *Star Wars* y coleccionista que soy, la Ciudad de las Nubes había ocupado siempre el primer lugar en mi lista de deseos personal, así que no tardé en empezar a pensar en diferentes conceptos. Para mí, la *Esclavo I* pertenece a la Ciudad de las Nubes. Ningún set que no la incluyera parecería estar completo.

Más adelante, aún durante el proceso de diseño, me di cuenta de que tenía que hacer espacio dentro para guardar el bloque de carbonita con Han Solo™ congelado; si no, ¿cómo iba Boba Fett a transportar su botín? ¡Resultó ser un gran desafío al tratarse de un modelo tan pequeño!

¿Qué materiales de referencia usaste?

Mi principal fuente de referencias e inspiración fueron varias imágenes del Episodio V: *EL IMPERIO CONTRAATAACA*. Es interesante observar cómo cambia la iluminación en el escenario de la película, algo que afecta a los colores de ciertas zonas. Creo que los héroes llegan a primera hora de la mañana. Después, va pasando el día y, cuando huyen, el sol se está poniendo. Este fue un aspecto que consideré importante al elegir los colores de la plataforma de aterrizaje, por ejemplo; sé que en realidad es gris, pero nunca se ve de ese color en la película. Eso fue lo que me llevó a elegir cafés más cálidos y oscuros para esa zona.



Hans Burkhard Schlömer

¿Qué es lo que más te inspira del escenario de la Ciudad de las Nubes?

Como diseñador, el diseño del escenario de la película me parece sencillamente asombroso. Posee un estilo *art déco* muy sutil. Tiene un montón de pequeños detalles que sólo se descubren poniendo mucha atención. Quería que esos detalles estuvieran en mi set. ¡Todos!

La atmósfera y los colores también cambian al pasar de un área a la siguiente. ¡Es como un código cromático! Mientras que las salas y los pasillos son principalmente blancos, diáfanos y amplios al inicio, todo eso da paso rápidamente a un opresivo rojo oscuro al entrar en el área de prisiones. Mi detalle favorito son los “ojos amenazantes” que hay en las paredes exteriores de las celdas: luminarias que te miran con furia al pasar junto a ellas.

¿Cuál fue la parte más complicada del proceso de diseño?

El de la Ciudad de las Nubes no fue un proceso de diseño como el resto. La mayoría de los interiores ya estaban ahí desde el principio de un modo u otro, pero el concepto general cambió unas cuantas veces. Uno de los mayores desafíos fue conectar todas las salas de tal manera que al hacerlo dieran forma al modelo. Las cuatro vigas superiores, que conforman el techo o la coraza exterior de la Ciudad de las Nubes, cumplen muy bien con este objetivo sin obstruir las áreas de juego. Nuestra meta era desarrollar un lenguaje de diseño similar al del set de la Estrella de la Muerte, pero usando menos bricks y con todas las salas a la misma altura.

¿Qué te gusta más del set?

¡En realidad, hay dos cosas que me gustan mucho! Una es que las salas están organizadas de forma lógica, lo cual permite representar toda la historia tal como sucede en la película. La otra es que el set incluye dos vehículos a pequeña escala y uno es un auto-nube de doble cápsula: ¡no lo veíamos en formato LEGO® desde hace muchísimo tiempo!

¿En qué se diferencia este set de otros en los que hayas trabajado?

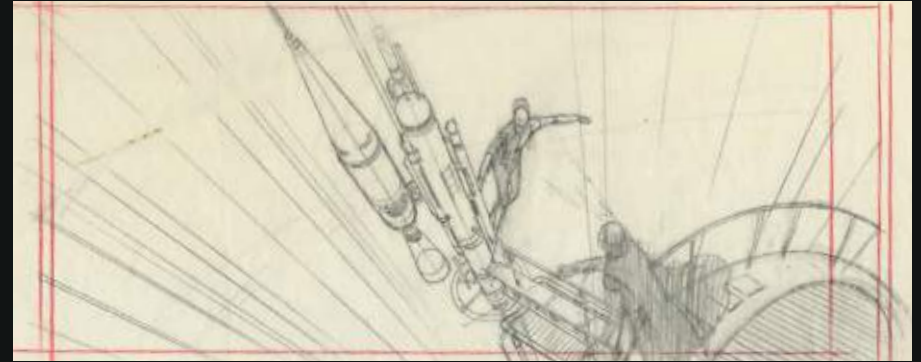
Definitivamente, la Ciudad de las Nubes es el set más grande que he creado hasta hoy. ¡Diseñarlo me llevó aún más tiempo del que invertí en el *Millennium Falcon*™ UCS!

¿Hay algo del diseño original que no haya llegado a la versión final?

Desde afuera, la Ciudad de las Nubes parece un hongo flotante. Sin embargo, me encargaron específicamente un set de juego y estos tienen que ser muy estables y accesibles. Lo que trato de decir es que colocar el set en un soporte a gran altura y encerrarlo en una vitrina no era una opción. Para alcanzar la calidad que queríamos ofrecer, necesitábamos una solución que acercara la plataforma al suelo. Aparte de eso, ¡casi todo lo demás que quería que estuviera en el set está adentro de la caja!

¿Qué parte del set podría sorprender a los constructores?

Los numerosos y variados modelos que componen el set pueden sorprender a más de uno, ¡pero será una sorpresa agradable! Por ejemplo, en la bolsa número dos encuentras un amplio surtido de elementos para construir una detallada nave espacial. Sin embargo, ¡la siguiente bolsa sólo contiene bricks! Son bricks grandes que se usan para crear la base en cruz de la Ciudad de las Nubes. En general, la secuencia de construcción debe tener sentido, ser interesante y proporcionar una extraordinaria experiencia hasta la última bolsa. ¡Disfrute de su estancia en las nubes!

CONOCE AL DISEÑADOR GRÁFICO

Madison O'Neil

¿Cuál es el primer paso a la hora de diseñar las minifiguras de un set?

El primer paso de todos es determinar qué personajes formarán parte del set, así como los requisitos de cada uno de ellos en cuanto a diseño. ¿Hacen falta nuevos elementos o elementos que ya existan en nuevos colores? ¿Cuántos elementos impresos se necesitan? ¿Los personajes requieren textiles? ¿Cuáles son las mejores maneras de darles novedad y emoción a personajes tan clásicos? Una vez contestadas estas preguntas, podemos dar paso a otras tareas de diseño más específicas.

¿Qué tipo de materiales de referencia usaste?

La Ciudad de las Nubes es uno de los lugares más clásicos y emblemáticos, así que fue fácil reunir materiales de referencia. Mi forma favorita de recopilar referencias es buscar en la película y capturar imágenes de las escenas o los personajes que necesito. Siempre descubro detalles nuevos, incluso después de ver la película muchísimas veces. En el caso de este set, me llevé una gran sorpresa cuando descubrí que la capa de Lando está forrada por dentro con una tela muy elaborada, un detalle que pudimos incorporar a su minifigura.

¿Cómo transmites la personalidad de un personaje mediante su diseño?

En el caso de las minifiguras, la personalidad viene determinada casi exclusivamente por las expresiones faciales. En la parte delantera de la cabeza de una minifigura, acostumbramos dibujar el rostro del personaje con una expresión más o menos neutra, una leve sonrisa o el ceño un poco fruncido, dependiendo de quién se trate. Es en la parte trasera de la cabeza donde llevamos la expresión un poco más allá para capturar otro aspecto de la personalidad del personaje o la historia. Por ejemplo, la amplia y encantadora sonrisa de Lando o el desconcierto de Luke al descubrir (alerta de spoiler) que Darth Vader™ es su padre.



Madison O'Neil

Aunque son muy pequeñas, las minifiguras requieren frecuentemente muchos detalles. ¿Cómo logras incorporar “disfraces” y rostros detallados a figuras tan pequeñas?

Existe un cierto nivel de detalle que se considera “ADN LEGO® Star Wars” y todo lo que va más allá suele ser descartado por no ajustarse a la estética establecida.

El diseño de una minifigura pasa por dar prioridad a los aspectos más importantes y emblemáticos del personaje, eliminando, quizá, aquellos detalles que no puedan representarse bien a escala de minifigura.

¿Qué minifigura te gustó más diseñar? ¿Cuál te pareció más difícil?

Las decoraciones que más me gustan de este set son también las que más trabajo me costó crear. Fue complicado reducir a escala de minifigura el diseño del traje que lleva la Princesa Leia en la Ciudad de las Nubes, al igual que el patrón de la cara interna de la capa de Lando. Sin embargo, creo que tanto esos detalles como los nuevos trajes son novedades fantásticas para el surtido LEGO Star Wars y de seguro les encantarán a los fans.



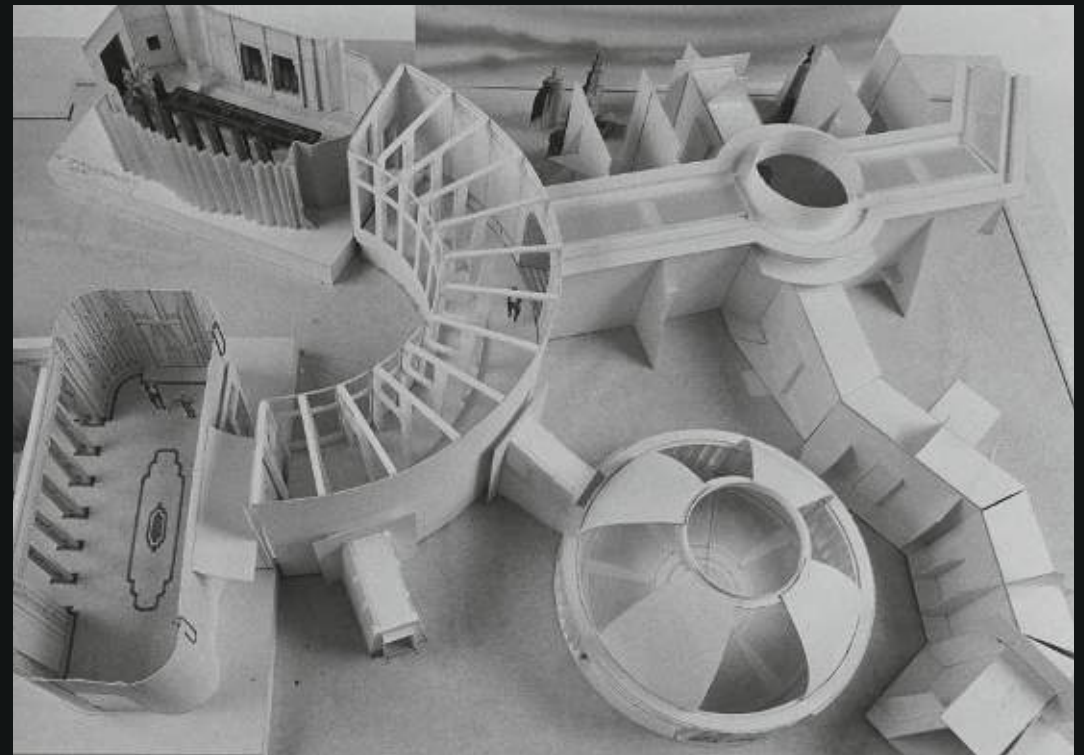
